SUMMARY

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PAJARO REGIONAL FLOOD MANAGEMENT AGENCY

The Board of Directors of the Pajaro Regional Flood Management Agency gives notice of its adoption of Ordinance No. 2023-01, opting into the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act and establishing informal bidding procedures for public projects. This Ordinance was initially introduced at the Board of Directors' meeting on March 8, 2023. The Ordinance provides that public projects less than \$60,000 may be performed by Agency employees by force account, negotiated contract, or purchase order approved by the Executive Director; public projects more than \$60,000 and up to than \$200,000 may be let to contract by informal bidding procedures; and public projects greater than \$200,000 shall be let to contract by formal bidding procedures.

The ordinance was adopted at the regular Board of Directors meeting on May 10, 2023 by the following vote:
